

MA Counseling degree

- In the MA in Counseling program there are 95 quarter units (the equivalent of 63 semester credits)
- Tuition for 2023-24 year is \$626/quarter unit.
- \$300 educational resource fee per quarter.
- Entire program estimate is: \$59,470. *
- Full-time students take 8 or more quarter units
- Part-time students take 4 quarter units

*Does not include educational resource fee.

Direct Costs:	Payable to SWC
Tuition	\$626 per Unit <i>Students can choose to enroll full-time (2.5 years), three-quarter time (3 years) or part-time (3.5 years or 4 years) in the M.A. in Counseling Program. The annual tuition cost is based on the program plan and length of the program you choose. Tuition is subject to increase each year.</i>
Educational Resource Fee	\$300 per quarter
Fees	\$50 application fee (new students only)
Indirect Costs:	Estimated (full and reasonable) costs a full-time student can expect. These are not paid to SWC, but rather based upon estimates of external costs a student may have.
Room & Board (average cost)	\$19,424 annually (\$4,856 per quarter/10 weeks) <i>SWC does not have on-campus housing and/or a dining hall, thus the amounts for Room & Board are based on local, average Room & Board costs. These figures are updated annually using local and national (comparisons) for rental averages.</i>
Books & Supplies (average cost)	\$1,600 annually (\$400 per quarter)
Transportation (average cost)	\$5,076 annually (\$1,269 per quarter)
Miscellaneous/Personal (average cost)	\$2,768 annually (\$692 per quarter)
Personal Therapy	\$650 per academic year* (\$163 per quarter) <i>*Art Therapy/Counseling and Counseling Programs only.</i>
