- 1. Southwestern College signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50% of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the ARP Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 2. Southwestern College received \$49,882 from the Department of Education for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students from the ARP Act.
- 3. As of September 30, 2021, \$14,960 had been granted to students as Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the ARP Act.
- 4. The total number of students who were eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants were 137.
- 5. The total number of students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under the student portion of Section 18004(a)(1) is 31 as of September 30.
- Responsibility for managing the application process was assigned to the Dean of the College.
   The Dean of the College is using the same methodology developed for HEERF I funds and used for HEERF II funds.
  - Every student who made a request received funding.
  - If the request was under \$500, it was funded at 100% of the requested amount.
  - If the request was \$500 or more, \$500 was granted.
- All students enrolled in Summer Quarter 2021 were emailed information about the ARP Act funds and how to apply for an emergency grant. (Appendix A, June 28, 2021, email to students)

Students were notified they received a grant. (Appendix C, sample email award notification to students)
