# **Cost of Attendance**

Cost of Attendance (COA) is the total estimate of what it costs to attend the school for one Academic Year. It includes **Direct Costs** (Tuition and Fees – what you pay directly to the school) and **Indirect Costs** (housing, food, transportation, misc. personal expenses, books, materials, equipment, supplies, loan fees, and \*personal therapy (\*for ATCN, ATCP, and CN students only)).

The figures below represent the total *estimated* Cost of Attendance for the program, based on your chosen program planner. Tuition, fees, and indirect cost allowances are subject to change each year and are evaluated on an annual basis using national and local average living costs. As a private institution, SWC does not differentiate between "In-state" and "Out-of-state" or Ground vs. Online tuition costs.

The Cost of Attendance establishes the limit on how much aid a student can receive for an academic year.

The maximum quarterly indirect cost allowance for a full-time quarter (6 or more units) is \$7,955:

This means if you are enrolled in the PhD program and take 6 or more units during a quarter, you can borrow up to \$7,955 for living expenses for that quarter. If you are enrolled in 3-5 units during a quarter, you can borrow up to \$7,180 for living expenses during that quarter.
